

Fiche D1-i Eituenanut anite mishue innu-assit

Nishuait eituenanu anite innu-aimunit : Natimit mak Mamit.

Anite itetshe Natimit nishuait anite katipanakanu eshi-aiminanut : anitshenat ka apashtaht nenu kapapeikushtesht [l], anite ka utshipaniht Pessamit, Mashteuiatsh kie Essipit. Minuat ne apitu innu-assia tekuaki, ka apashtaht kapapeikushteshinit [n], anite ka utshipaniht Uashat, Mani-utenam mak nete Matimekush/Lac John.

Nete eituenanut Mamit : nishtuait anite katipanakanu eshi-aiminanut: anitshenat ka apashtaht kapapeikushteshinit [n], anite ka utshipaniht Pakutshipit, Unaman-shipit, Nutashkuanit mak Ekuanitshit. Ne kutak katipanikanit, [n] iapit apashtauat eimitaui nete Tshishe-shatshit. Ek^u, mashten takuan kutak eshi-aiminanut, ishinikateu mushuau anitshenat Natuashish innuat ishi-aimuat.

Kassinu anitshenat eshi-aimiht peikuaht itashtauat meshinaitshetaui, muk^u anitshenat Mashteuiatsh ait itashtauat meshinaitshetaui.

Mate passe ne tshekuan ait eshinakuak :

- ne kapeikushtesht [l] iapashtakanit aiminanuti nete Pessamit, Essipit kie Mashteuiatsh miam anite aimunit innu ka ishi-uitakanit [i:lnu]
- neme pietakuak [h] anite mamit, miam anite aimunit shash [ha:h]
- nenu sh [ʃ] pietakuak anite apitu innu-assia tekuaki
- ait eshinikatakaniti passe aimuna, ussi-aimuna etutakanitau.
